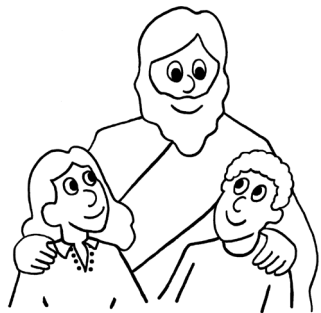

Here is a doorknob hanger for your room in God's house.


Write your name on the line.

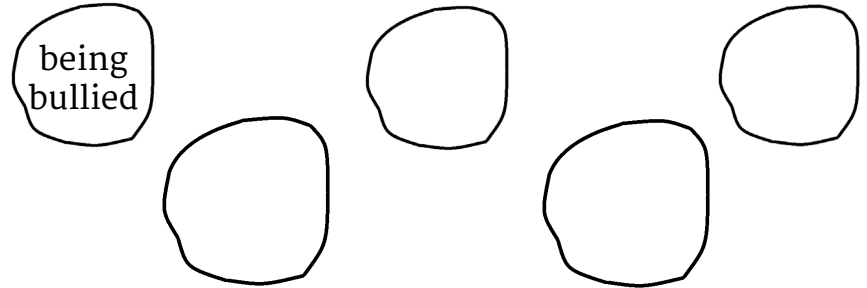
